CHALLENGING SCHEDULES

Many couples today are juggling crazy schedules. Work, school, personal commitments, and other factors can make it difficult — even impossible — to attend a traditional classroom-style event. This online Pre-Cana is available on-demand, ready when they are: anytime, anywhere.

SEPARATED BY DISTANCE

This program is delivered online, so couples can experience it from different countries and time zones. Couples often use Skype or other video chat platforms for face-to-face, live interaction as they work through the course. Other couples work through the course at different times.

LIMITED ALTERNATIVES

The Church commonly offers marriage prep classes, or Pre-Cana courses, as "gathered events" with many couples together at the same time and place. While these can be great experiences, couples may not find an available date that fits their needs.

BALANCING VALUES, CAREERS, AND PRACTICAL ISSUES

Many couples get married before discussing, let alone experiencing, the effect that practical issues will have on their relationship. Couples that have been building their relationship for a long time often say, "We're practically married already." or "Nothing's going to change." The facts are, "No, they aren't." and, "Yes, it will."



FINANCES

Financial matters are among the top reasons for marital trouble and the increasing number of divorces in America, now hovering around 50%. Each day presents many decisions related to finances, and couples often have differences of opinion about spending that can lead to arguments and resentment. This video session presents important talking points for engaged couples to discuss and practical advice to implement.



HEALTHY SEXUALITY AND INTIMACY

A healthy, loving sex life is among the most important factors to a happy, lasting marriage. Oftentimes, relationship issues related to sex are actually the result of poor communication between husband and wife.

In this segment, couples will benefit from professional advice and conversation-starters. By talking through these sensitive topics during their engagement, they will undoubtedly position their marriage for a lifetime of healthy, exciting, and fulfilling intimacy.

Relationships are all about communication. Happy, healthy marriages require frequent and honest communication between husband and wife. This life skill is among the most important, requiring a commitment to keep learning more effective ways to relate to one another.



THEOLOGY AND SPIRITUALITY OF MARRIAGE

A marriage within the Catholic Church leads to a deeper meaning of marriage itself. The covenant formed on the wedding day is not merely between two human beings. The greater significance of observing this holy union is the bond that is formed between man, woman, and God.

But what happens after the thrill and excitement of that day begins to wear off?

This four-part series helps couples explore what it means to uphold the commitment of a Catholic marriage — as their unified life begins — by developing a *Family Spirituality*. Presented in a profound yet approachable method, these video segments help spark meaningful discussions between engaged couples.

It also speaks to individuals who may not be Catholic, allowing the opportunity for those who *are* Catholic to share the beauty of their faith with their future husband or wife.

Whether they maintain a close relationship with their family or not, they will soon discover how their fiancé(e) has been influenced and shaped as a person and a spouse by their family of origin.



NATURAL FAMILY PLANNING

For some couples, having children is the last thing on their minds as they plan for marriage. Other couples may be planning to start a family right away. Some might even look to artificial contraception methods to prevent or avoid pregnancy. When couples opt for artificial methods, they often overlook the harmful effect those methods can have on their relationship and their spirituality.

However, it is important to talk about parenthood at this stage. By learning one another's expectations for having children, couples will grow in their understanding of each other as potential parents.

We also understand that not all individuals are able to have children and how devastating that can be. The procreative aspect of marriage also includes an openness to life — something often referred to as "spiritual fertility." This means there are other ways that the love a husband and wife share can be fruitful: volunteering, adoption, edifying the community, and serving the Church.

SELF-LED


Engaged Couples Working Through The Program On Their Own Time

Living Our Faith in Love has multiple self-led elements. The packet downloaded at the beginning includes "His and Hers" discussion guides that encourage meaningful conversations and reflection throughout the experience of marriage preparation.

A series of video presentations is delivered online, each followed by a reflection exercise, or quiz. For accountability, they can't move forward in the course until all the questions are answered correctly. These reflection exercises are intended to ensure that couples gain thorough understanding of the topic.

Once all of the topics have been completed, a "Print Your Certificate" button will appear and their certificate will be available as a PDF file.

MENTOR-LED


Engaged Couples Working With A Facilitator, Clergy, or Sponsor Couple

The engaged couple has an initial meeting (live or remote) with their facilitator(s) that will accompany them through the preparation process. In this initial meeting, they review the course contents included in *Living Our Faith in Love* and agree on a schedule to work through it.



For example, everyone agrees to reconvene every Sunday evening for 4-6 weeks. In between each meeting, the engaged couple works through a couple segments of the course. This way, when they reconvene with their facilitator(s), they come to the table already having processed the course content. They watched videos, completed exercises, and filled out His & Hers Discussion Guides.

This method sets everyone up for a true ministry of accompaniment in an efficient manner that respects the time being volunteered by facilitators. Prior to each weekly meeting, the engaged couple already put in the work of learning on their own time, allowing facilitators to serve as mentors, not teachers.



NATURAL FAMILY PLANNING: NFP LIFETM




NFP Life is a six-part online, on-demand program introducing the beauty, the science, and the Catholic theology that reinforces the good news of Natural Family Planning.






